The vendor mix will include local crafts, cottage industry foods, artisans, horse/pet care products, tack shops, stables, and sellers of “sustainable” and “eco-friendly” products.

Other attractions at the Country Fair include Pony rides, Riding demonstrations, Agricultural exhibits, Live music, Midway games, Petting farm, Silent Auction, Book and Thrift sale, and numerous free activities.

The vendors are located in a large covered arena. The space is usually shared with the petting farm and sale, as well as some food vendors so it is a busy place!

Although the arena is covered it has no sides so it can be a bit drafty so dress warmly.

The cost of one vendor space is (10' x 10') is \$50.00. Vendors will need to provide their own canopy/tent (optional) and table(s).

Vendors may commence setting up any time after 7:00 a.m. We ask that vendors be fully set up and ready for business by 9:00.

Be aware that vendors might be unable to drive right into the arena to unload their goods so come prepared. (It all depends on the flow of traffic)

Parking for vendors is designated on the road once you have unloaded.
