



— SUMMER CLASSIC SETUP —

Preparation for the Summer Classic is gearing up, and will progress as follows:

- ❖ We will be putting up tents, sound systems and flagging starting on Sunday July 10th.
- ❖ Jumps will be removed from the Covered, Big, McCutcheon and McCleery Rings on Monday, July 11. The course designer will be building warm-up courses on Tuesday, July 12; warm-up day is Wednesday, July 13. The show starts at 7:30 a.m. on Thursday, July 14 and runs through to Sunday, July 17.
- ❖ There will be no lessons on the property after Monday, July 11.

❖ The Dressage Ring and Carnarvon Ring will be open for non-competing SRC members only for the duration of the show. As this is an EC national competition, once the show starts (Thursday), only



horses entered in the competition are allowed on the competition grounds. Members may ride in the warm-up areas after classes have ended each day (i.e. the Track, Indoor, McCleery and Big Ring). Competition areas – the Covered Arena, McCutcheon Ring and Grand Prix field – are closed until the show ends.

- ❖ We will post notices at the entrance gates to the grounds notifying members about setup and closures.

Please come out to watch and support your fellow SRC members throughout the competition! Sarah's Kitchen will be open in the Clubhouse, as well as other concessions on site. Make a note of the times for our most popular classes:

The Teams of Three Hunters Costume Class (and Happy Hour) is Friday, July 15 at approximately 5:30 p.m. The Mini Prix and Modified Grand Prix are on Saturday, July 16 afternoon and the ever popular Derbies get under way on Sunday, July 17 morning.

The Green and Open Green are offered as combined divisions with no age split.

Green (Pre-Training Test A/2'9")

Open Green (Pre-Training Test A/Cross Country 2'9" with 3' options/Stadium 3')

The Newbie Green Division is for riders who have not competed at Green level previously. More details are available on the prize list, which is available on the SRC website or at the Clubhouse. Dressage tests are available on the www.horsetrialsbc.com website. Note that for this event, entries need to go to Entry Secretary Trevor Clarke (address on entry form), **not the SRC Office.**
