The Club's Junior and Intermediate members invite you to enter the annual "2-3/4 Phase Event", taking place at SRC on June 18 and 19. Although it's organized by the Jr/Int committee, riders of all ages are welcome! Dressage is on the Saturday, and Stadium and Cross-country phases on the Sunday.

The following divisions are offered in both Jr/Int and Senior categories:

**Starter** (Entry Test A/2'3")

**Pre-Green** (Entry Test B/2'6")

**Newbie Green** (Entry Test B/2'9")

The Green and Open Green are offered as combined divisions with no age split.

**Green** (Pre-Training Test A/2'9")

**Open Green** (Pre-Training Test A/Cross Country 2'9" with 3' options/Stadium 3')

The Newbie Green Division is for riders who have not competed at Green level previously. More details are available on the prize list, which is available on the SRC website or at the Clubhouse. Dressage tests are available on the [www.horsetrialsbc.com](http://www.horsetrialsbc.com) website. Note that for this event, entries need to go to Entry Secretary Trevor Clarke (address on entry form), not the SRC Office.

**Entries close on Monday, June 13 at 5:00 p.m.** Because of scheduling requirements, no late entries will be accepted after the closing date.
