



MARCH CLINICS

March at SRC offers our members a choice of schooling events in Hunter, Jumper and Dressage. We have two popular H/J clinicians returning this spring: Claudia Cojocar on March 5-7 and Judy Brawley on March 19-21. The Dressage Test Riding Clinic is scheduled for March 28.

H/J Clinic with Claudia Cojocar

Two sessions, two hours in duration, with a maximum of six riders per group. Groups are available for riders jumping at 3', 3'-3,3", and 3'6"-3'9". Cost for SRC members is \$245 + GST, or \$255 +GST for non-members.

H/J Clinic with Judy Brawley

Three sessions, two hours in duration, with a maximum of six riders per group. The first session is flatwork, with the other two sessions taking place over fences. Groups are available for 2'6" (open), 2'9" (AA/Junior) and 3'6" (open). Cost for SRC members is \$325, or \$335 for non-members.

Dressage Test Riding Clinic with Nancy Olson-Beaulieu

Our first Test Riding Clinic in January was so well received that we're running a second one! Riders can sign up for one or two dressage tests; if riding two tests they will be scheduled back to back. Clinician Nancy Olson-Beaulieu (EC Level I) will provide feedback after each ride. Riders will receive a test score sheet with comments. Cost for two test rides is \$50 and for one test ride is \$25.

Full details on all clinics, and registration forms, are available on the SRC website and in the Clubhouse lobby. For all clinics, payment is required to reserve your space, and wait lists will be maintained once the clinic (or height category) is full.

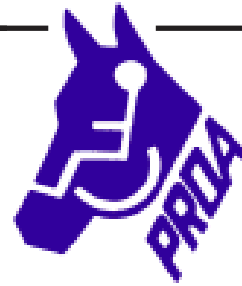
