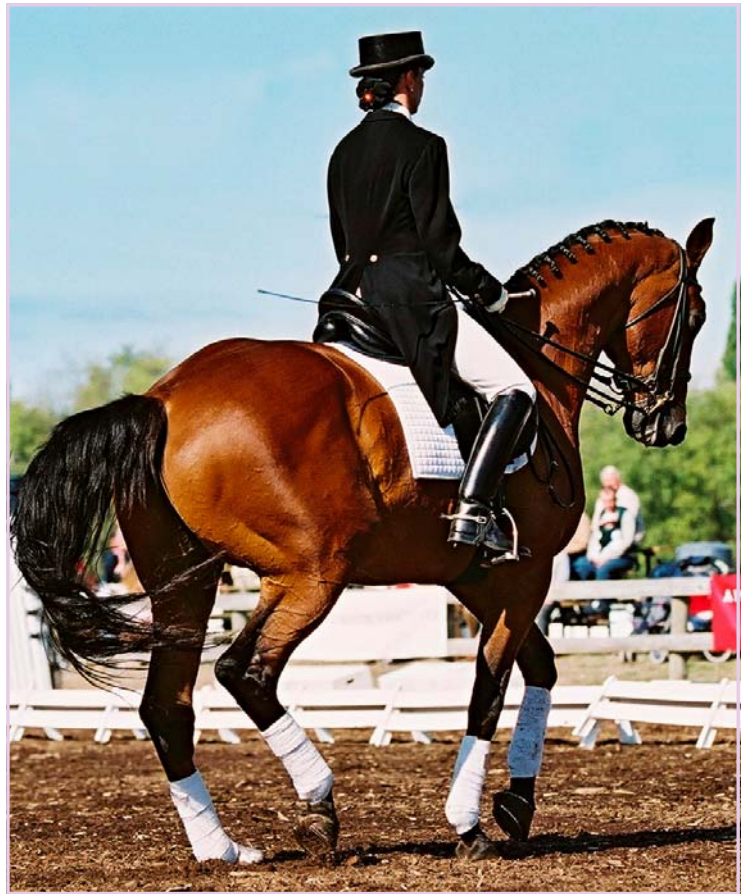
MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL TIME!!!
